

Bible Study for June 7-13, 2021

Read: 2 Corinthians 5:6-17

Notes:

In today's lesson, Paul encourages believers to live by faith and not by sight. We do not consider Jesus from a human perspective but through the eyes of faith, believing he died for all and was raised. All who are in Christ are now in God's new creation.

Questions to Ponder:

Of all the places you have lived, which was your favorite home?

Looking at verses 6-10, how does Paul's idea of "home" affect his daily living?

What is Paul's motive for evangelism in verses 10-11? In verse 14? How do they fit together?

How would someone motivated by these values stand in contrast to someone motivated by those mentioned in 5:12?

What is your definition of "reconciliation"? What story from your life illustrates this?

What motivates you to share your faith? If you rarely do so, what inhibits you?
