From the Pastor's Pen....

MARY



March promises us spring. Sunny days are clearly warmer, although the weather can be quite unpredictable. There is a saying in Italy that you should always bring an umbrella in March. Maybe in

these latitudes I would still bring a scarf and gloves.

We have already entered the season of Lent. Before we know it, March will be over and we will be living the Easter season. In our congregation, this year we are experimenting with how the Lenten series works every other week in Finnish and English. The place also changes every other week, between Finlandia Village chapel and Regent Street. Experiments and renewal can also be done in the church. Sometimes it's the only option.

The Sunday that remembers and honors Mary falls in the middle of March in the Finnish church year. I suppose it's some sort of memory from Roman Catholicism, and for some a bit of a strange holiday: What should a Lutheran think about Mary, and even in the middle of Lent? In the Canadian Lutheran church, Annunciation of our Lord is celebrated on the 25th of March, but not specifically at a Sunday service. Of course, some genius has calculated that in March it will be exactly 9 months until Christmas, i.e. the birth of Jesus. Aha!

Martin Luther had a lot to say about the saints and also about Mary, of whose position as intercessors he was critical. The Christian's only intercessor is Jesus Christ; no other middlemen or women are needed. Luther uses Mary and her

life as an example of God's grace and way of working. During her life, Mary experienced suffering and anxiety, according to Luther, this is a comforting example for other Christians. The suffering experienced by the mother of Christ gives comfort to other sufferers. Mary is also an example through her eternal virginity, but not as we think, concretely and physically, but spiritually: Just as Mary is untouchable in marriage under the authority of a man, the Christian is also free from the authority of the law thanks to the liberating effect of the gospel. Although Mary's faith is profound and exemplary, Mary's exemplary nature also includes her fallibility. God takes away this faith from Mary so that she would understand that she needs God and not fall back on her own merits. Mary considers herself the greatest of sinners and is therefore, according to Luther, a true saint. Mary's faith is also exemplary because Mary strives to grow in it after her mistake. Luther

sees the mother of Jesus as an exemplary Christian and a Christian example in several different ways. Mary's exemplary faith, when the angel announced that she would become pregnant under the influence of the Holy Spirit, is

apt to inspire and support Christians when matters of faith seem contrary to reason and impossible.

During Lent, we are invited to see and wonder, like Mary, at God's wonderful works. The focus of Lent is on Easter, on the resurrection of Christ, which takes place by God's power and love. Although it can sometimes be difficult and strange for us to understand, we can believe in the Resurrection even though it is against reason and impossible. We don't have much faith, even more faithlessness, but we can trust that God will give you faith even when it is impossible to find it yourself. Jesus Christ prays without ceasing for you and your faith. Amen.

Chairman's Report

March has arrived and with its arrival, our Lenten season continues. During the season of Lent, we are holding services on Thursday's alternating between Finlandia and Regent Street. Please check the calendar for location and time.

March also brings us two other events. On Sunday March 10 we need to turn our clocks forward to start Day light savings time and on March 21 we get to welcome the first day of spring. With spring just around the corner, we start to think about planting seeds for new growth and watching existing plants awake from their winter slumber and begin a new season.

Spring is hopefully also the start of the construction season at Finlandia. We should see the start of the Tammi Koti building. Our new worship space will be located on the second floor of this building. As I write this article Finlandia has plans to break ground for the building and rearrange roads and parking this spring. The timing of this is dependent on getting an approved building permit and acquiring an acceptable tender for the construction of the project.

The construction phase for the new building will be at least 2 years. During that time there will be disruptions to traffic flow and parking around Lepokoti. This may result in some parking issues for our Sunday services. Hopefully these will be minimal.


